Networking Meeting for Gender Equality Action Plan 2017–20

The University of Zurich's Gender Equality Action Plan 2017–20 was drawn up as part of the swissuniversities P-7 programme Equal opportunity and university development. The Action Plan 2017-20 Network organizes events in connection with the action plan and equality matters at UZH, at which participants can exchange views and debate issues.

Gender, Excellence and Academic Research Funding

This event is all about examining how research funding intersects with gender and excellence. National research funding organizations and universities play a crucial role, but despite sustained efforts over time, progress is slow in terms of promoting gender equality in research funding, academic excellence and in shaping research careers.

The speakers discuss the impact of best-practice measures in different national policy settings (Ireland, Austria and Switzerland), for example gender balance targets for research funding, increased diversity in the selection processes and in the decision-making bodies, unconscious bias awareness training, role models, and rethinking norms about how excellence is defined and quantified. What works, and what obstacles stand in the way of progress? What can countries and universities learn from each other?
