Goals

In this workshop participants will:

- receive information about funding possibilities with focus on [SNSF Career Funding](#)
- know the importance of being main applicant, and about traps esp. for female researchers
- know the differences, goodies, and challenges of the SNSF Career Funding Schemes Ambizione, PRIMA and others
- learn how to plan a convincing grant proposal: 4-step-model “golden rules” of the application process
- have a success orientated application strategy, with a convincing research question
- Methods: Theory and interactive exercises
